

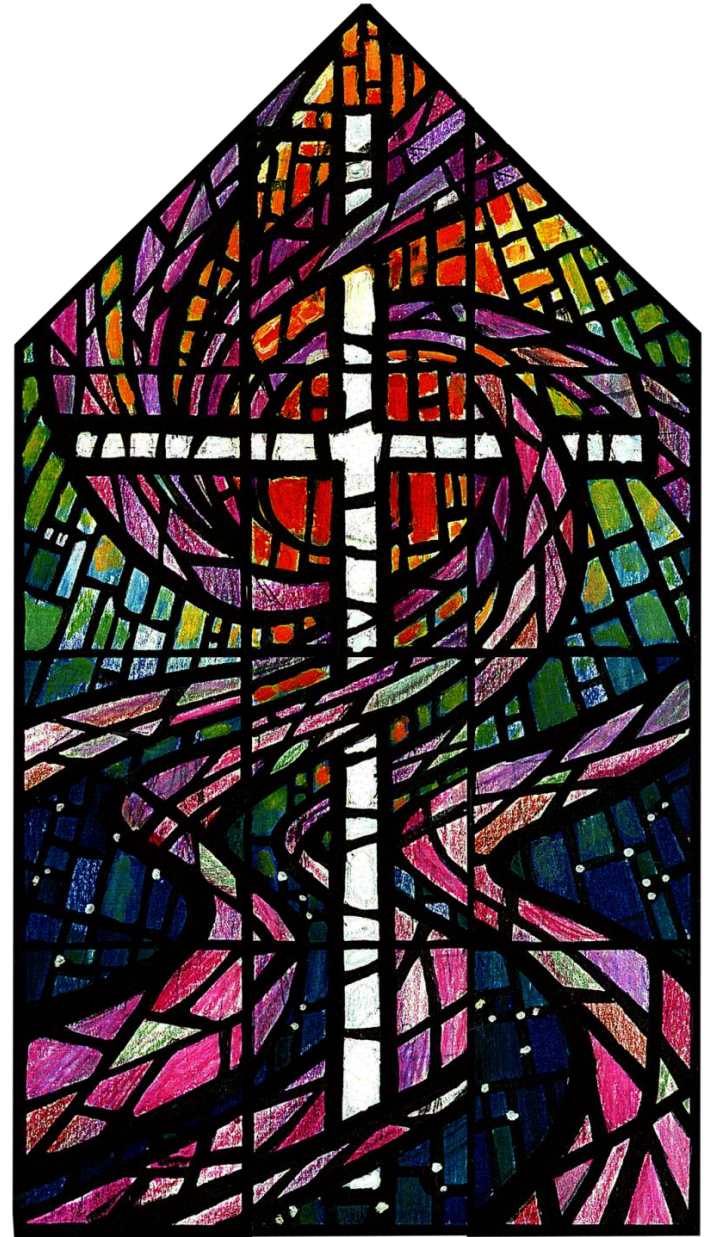
## Judson Baptist Church Announcements
